

# EASY COMPLETE SUN GARDEN



**KARL ROSENFELD PEONY (3)**

- Grows 30-36 inches tall
- Plant 18-36 inches apart
- Deer Resistant, Naturalizing
- Blooms in Spring



**BLACK EYED SUSAN (5)**

- Grows 18-30 inches tall
- Plant 10-18 inches apart
- Perennializing & Naturalizing
- Blooms in mid-summer



**MAY NIGHT SALVIA (6)**

- Grows 18-24 inches tall
- Plant 9-18 inches apart
- Perennializing & Deer Resistant
- Blooms in Early Summer



**AUTUMN JOY SEDUM (6)**

- Grows 15-18 inches tall
- Plant 12-18 inches apart
- Perennializing & Deer Resistant
- Attracts Butterflies & Hummingbirds
- Blooms in late summer

## PLANTING TIPS

1. We suggest you place all of the plants in position before you actually start to dig. This will verify that you have them spaced properly. This particular garden plan works with a gardening area that is 5ft x 10ft or 50 square feet. Feel free to make adjustments based off of how much space you have available.

2. First plant the Karl Rosenfield peonies in the back around 36 inches apart.

3. Plant the May Night salvia 20 inches in front of the peonies and around 9 inches apart from each other.

4. Plant the Autumn Joy sedum 9 inches in front of the salvia (on the right and left sides) and around 12 inches apart from one another.

6. Plant the Black Eyed susan in a front and center cluster. Make sure they are around 20 inches away from the peonies and around 10 inches away from the sedum.

7. Cut back foliage in fall after first hard frost.
