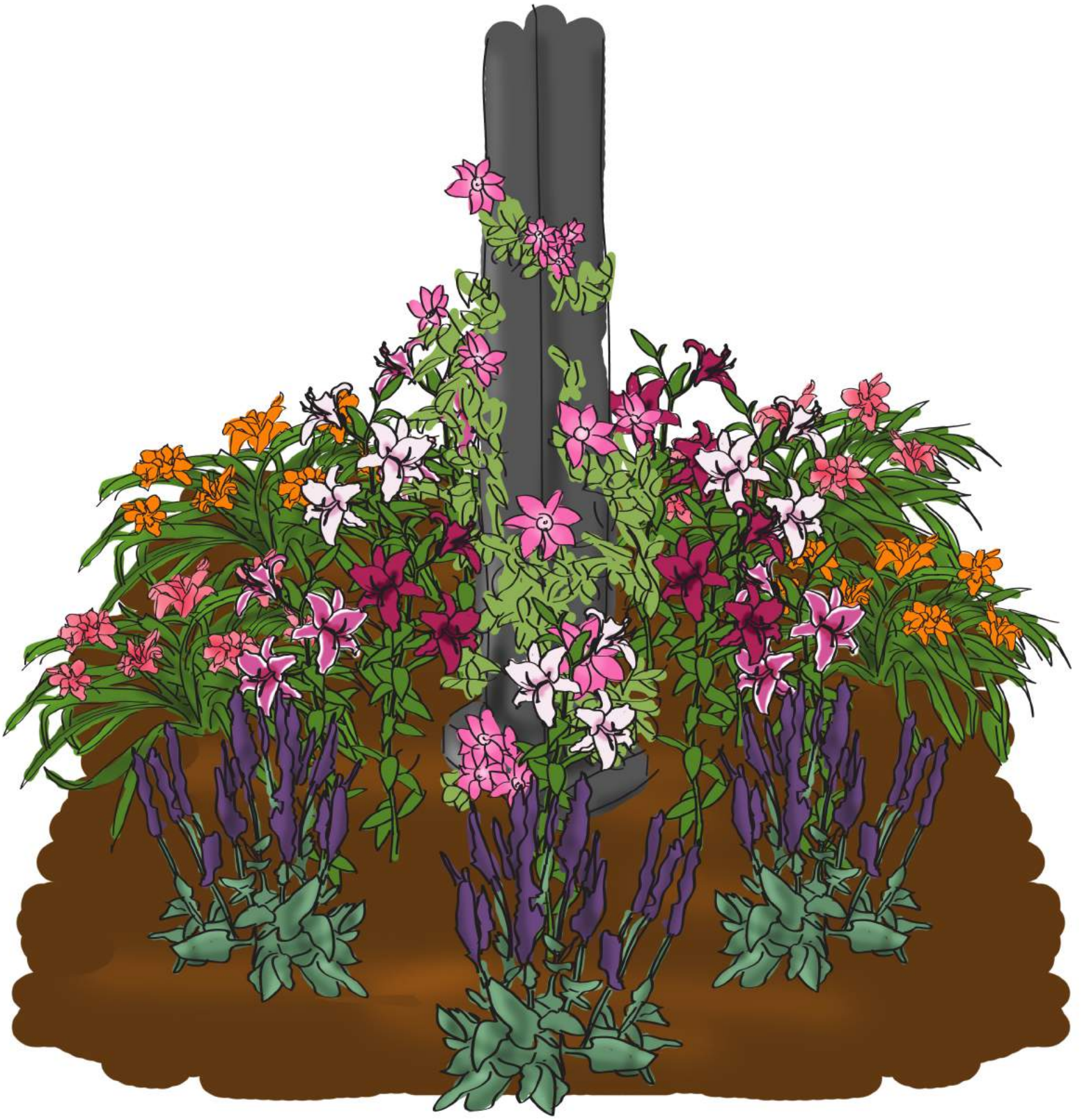

# LAMP POST or MAILBOX GARDEN



## DOUBLE PASSION DAYLILY (2)

- Blooms all summer
- Grows 18-25 inches tall
- Deadhead as blooms fade for longer bloomtime



## MAUNA LOA DAYLILY (2)

- Blooms mid summer
- Grows 22-24 inches tall
- Eye catching true orange color
- Deadhead as blooms fade for



## MAY NIGHT SALVIA (3)

- Blooms early summer
- Grows 18-24 inches tall
- Remove spent blooms to encourage more blooms throughout summer



## COMTESSE DE BOUCHAUD CLEMATIS (1)

- Blooms June to September
- Grows up to 144 inches
- Encourage upward growth during first few weeks by gently securing to structure



## SUMATRA LILY (3)

- Blooms mid summer
- Grows 24-36 inches tall
- Plant 4-6 inches deep
- Sweet fragrance



## MUSCADET LILY (3)

- Blooms mid summer
- Grows 24-36 inches tall
- Plant 4-6 inches deep
- Fragrant



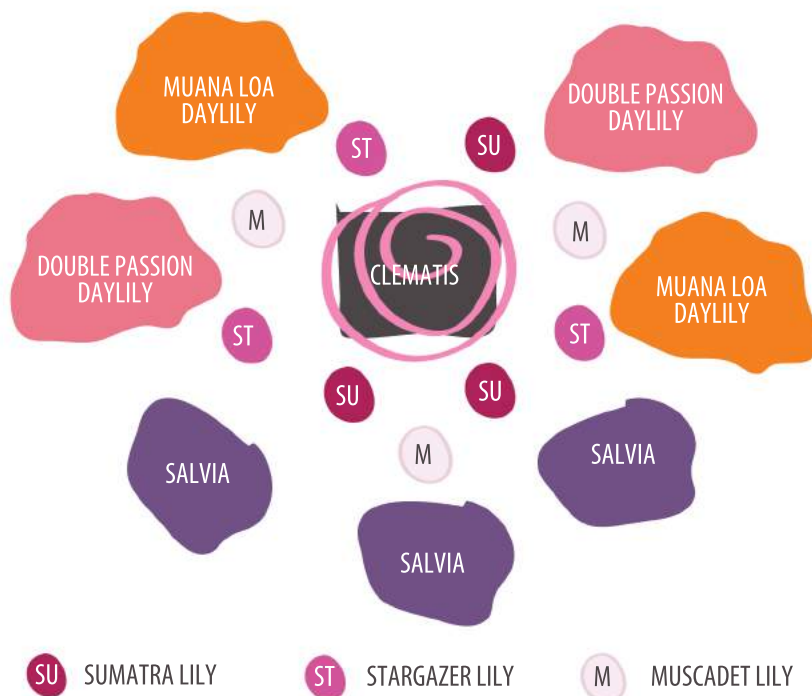
## STARGAZER LILY (3)

- Blooms mid summer
- Grows 24-36 inches tall
- Plant 4-6 inches deep
- Sweet fragrance

## PLANTING TIPS

- We suggest you place all the plants in position before you actually start to dig. This will help to verify that you have them spaced correctly.
- Plant clematis approx. 2 inches from post.
- Mix all 3 lily bulb varieties together. Plant in a slightly staggered circle around post approx. 4-6 inches apart.
- Plant the Daylilies on the "back half" of the bed, 18-24 inches apart. Place one each on either side of the post.
- Plant the Salvia in the "front half" of the bed, approx. 12-18 inches apart.
